

Underwater Welding



The Underwater Skills Department at Seneca College in partnership with Phoenix Marine Services, Abbotsford B.C. will be offering a course in underwater welding in February, 2003. The five-day course will allow practice and instruction to enable participants to attempt the underwater CWB "class B" (fillet welds, plate) test. The course is designed to allow commercial divers working within the diving industry to achieve Canadian U/W welding qualification.

Applicants to the course will need to have a working background in underwater welding. All divers will need an up-to-date diving medical to participate. It is expected that everyone enrolled in the course will achieve CWB class B, (all position) underwater qualification; however, due to material and time constraints, this cannot be guaranteed.

Date of course: February 17-21

Offered to: Commercial divers with U/W welding background and diving medical.

Location: Vancouver B.C.

Qualification Level: Canadian Welding Bureau (CWB) Class B, U/W Welding Qualification, in accordance with (ANSI/AWS), American National Standard Institute, American Welding Society D3.6, Specification for U/W Welding.
